Mark Dickel is the newly appointed Canterbury Rams head coach after spending the past three seasons with the Otago Nuggets. Mark played for the University of Nevada, Las Vegas from 1996 to 2000, tying for the team lead in assists his freshman year and led NCAA Division 1 men's basketball in assists his senior year. In 1995, Dickel was both junior and senior Tall Blacks player of the year. He represented New Zealand in the 2000 Sydney Olympics and 2004 Athens Olympic. He was third in assists per game at the 2002 FIBA World Championships leading New Zealand to the highest place finish at any international event by playing Yugoslavia in the semi finals. Dickel has played professionally all over the world including Belgium, Turkey, Russia, Germany, Greece and Australia.



Lori McDaniel is the recently appointed Canterbury Wildcats head coach after spending the past year coaching New Zealand Development Teams and the Canterbury Country U17 Girls. Lori played collegiately in the United States for Casper Junior College and NCAA Division 1 Butler University. Lori was an All American while playing at Casper. Lori has played for the Wildcats and locally in the Christchurch club competition. She is excited about developing the women's basketball pathway so more Canterbury players are representing New Zealand and playing throughout the world.



Caleb Harrison has recently returned to Canterbury as the Rams Development Coach after spending ten years coaching in the United States. Harrison has most recently been the head womens basketball coach at Dickinson State University. Caleb was an assistant coach for the Lambuth University National Champion team in 2007. He has a masters degree in sports coaching from Indiana State University and a bachelor of sports coaching degree from the University of Canterbury. Caleb is passionate about using his experience as a United States college coach in helping junior players throughout Canterbury in achieving their basketball and academic goals.
